

Callie Rohr Memorial Canoe Race June 13 & 14, 2009

This is a 26-mile two-day marathon canoe race on the historic Headwaters of the Wisconsin River. Paddlers can paddle, whole marathon, half marathon, or short paddle for a cure race. This beautiful fast and wild stream, with lots of challenging turns and obstacles, makes for an exciting and challenging race. The race heats will start at 9:00 AM each day. Recreation class paddlers will start from our RWT landing and travel half way down the racecourse to the landing at River Road. The next day the race will continue from River Road to the Eagle River Inn in Eagle River. The pro-racers will do the entire course in one day beginning at 9:00 AM on Sunday from RWT. Paddle For A Cure racers start at county G at 10:30 AM on Sunday, with all racers ending at the Eagle River Inn Sunday for an exciting finish. Spectators are welcome at Rohr's Wilderness Tours, River Road and at the Eagle River Inn, where there will be a pig roast, raffles, and an awards ceremony. There are also other exciting events planned for the race weekend. Racers will be divided into several classes with prizes and trophies given to the winners. The net proceeds from the race will be donated to the American Brain Tumor Association (ABTA) with direct fund raising also a part of this worthwhile and fun event.

Classes: Are designed to make the race as fair and fun as possible (*min of 3 boats per class entered by June 1st for awards*)

Full Marathon

Pro Classes-

1. C2 (USCA and pro specs) 2. C1 (USCA specs) 3. Kayak (*unlimited*)

4. Recreation Racers- *This class is designed to put the serious recreation racers into one class and make fairer competition in the more casual paddlers of the other recreation classes. . You know who you are! NO PRO BOATS (unlimited) Final designation by Judge.*

Recreation Classes-No racing boats, or tandem canoes with less than 33" at 4" waterline. Final designation by Judge.

5. Men's Tandem Canoe (2 men)

6. Women's Tandem Canoe (2 women)

7. Mixed Tandem Canoe (man and woman)

8. Adult Child Tandem Canoe (adult and child 12 and under)

9. Solo Canoe (*must not be racing canoe*)

10. Kayak (unlimited) **No Racing Hulls!**

11. Fat Boat (Wide aluminum or other slow fat or short boats. Will be determined by race judge)

Half Marathon

12. Half Marathon (Paddle the recreation course either day). (1st, 2nd, 3rd place ribbons will be given for each day) Average paddle time each day is 3 1/2 hours for this class. (unlimited) **No Racing Hulls**

13. Paddle For A Cure-A short 5 mile race starting at 10:30 on Sunday. (No trophies and not timed)

All paddlers must make time minimums or be pulled from the race. (County K 3 hrs first day, County G 3 1/2 hrs second day)

Boys or girls over the age of 12 are considered an adult and there must be one person over age 18 in each boat. Everyone is required to sign a release form and all participants under 18 must have parent or legal guardian sign release form.

Entry Fee- Pro's - \$25.00 p.p. Recreation paddlers - \$20.00 p.p. Half Marathon - \$15.00 p.p. Paddle for a cure-\$10.00 p.p.

All includes t-shirt if registered by June 1st and people shuttles. After June 1st (No t-shirt) add \$10.00. Race day add \$15.00.

Donations -Each racer is encouraged to raise money for this great cause, with awards given for the most money collected. All donations are greatly appreciated for this worthwhile cause. We are sure Callie is thanking you from heaven and all the children, who have suffered through this devastating disease, thank you as well.

All classes except pro's with permission \$75.00 Pro's-\$100.00 (limited number first come first serve)

All banners must be ordered by May 15th and can be used over multiple years.

Canoe Rentals There are a limited number of canoes and kayaks that can be rented for the race from Rohr's Wilderness Tours (RWT). Tandem canoe or double Kayak \$35.00 per day plus tax. Single Kayak \$30.00 per day plus tax. Includes: boat, paddles, life jackets, and boat shuttle.

Shuttles There will be free shuttles available after the race for people and a per boat per day fee of \$10.00 to transport your boat. Pre-registration required for boat shuttles.

Partner Pool If you want to participate but don't have a partner put your name in our partner pool and we will do our best to match you up with a paddling partner for this fun race and great cause.
